Attention all Students and Parents

The Delphi Community School Corporation has had been accepted into the USDA SFA feeding program. By participating in this program we will be able to continue providing a healthy lunch and breakfast, but at **no cost** to the student. This program will be available until December 31 or until funds are depleted, whichever comes first. Students were not charged for regular meals today, only for "extras".

The student account will be refunded for any paid and reduced meal charges for meals already served in August and September. We must access every individual account so please be patient as we are working on this. The credit in your student's account will remain until the student graduates or withdraws from school. No refund checks will be issued unless one of these actions take place. These are the rules established by the state.

Students will be able to buy second entrees, second meals, and/or a la carte items at the current pricing as long as the student has available funds in their account to purchase them.
